Family Life began in 1957 as a youth program in New York's southern tier. The radio network launched in 1983 with one station and now broadcasts on 25 full-power stations, nearly a dozen high power translators, and about 29 low-power translators. Family Life covers major portions of New York and Pennsylvania as well as around the world through the internet.
